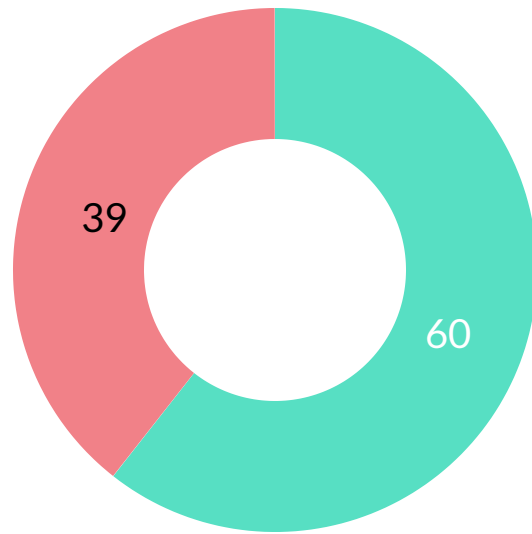

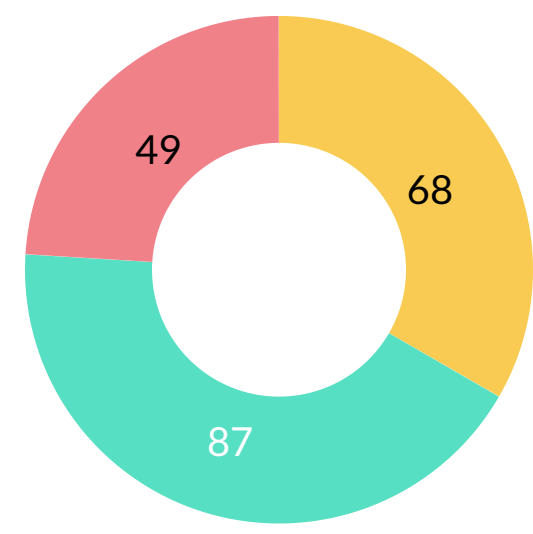

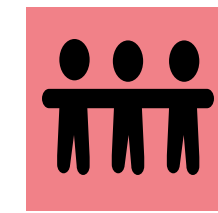

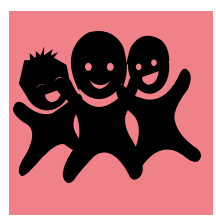


Race/Ethnicity of Children Served



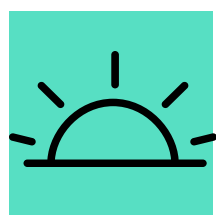

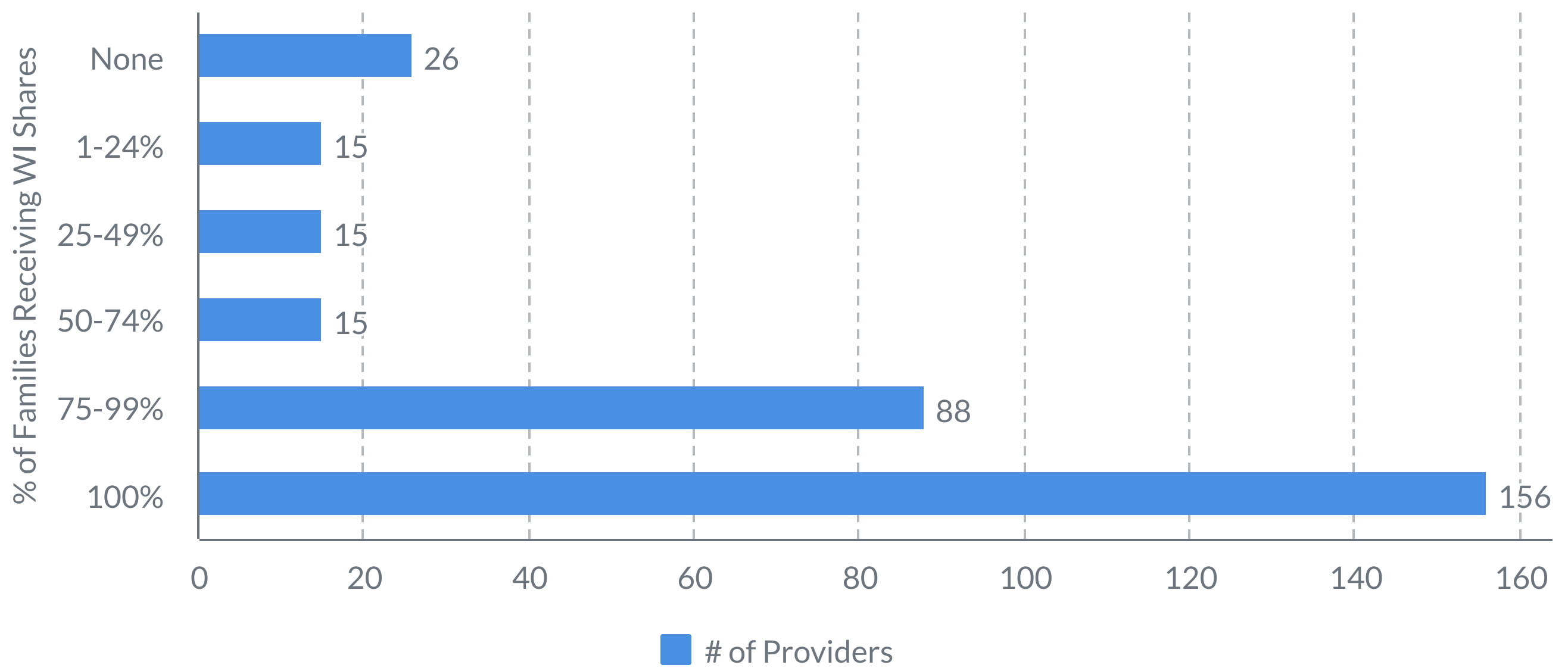

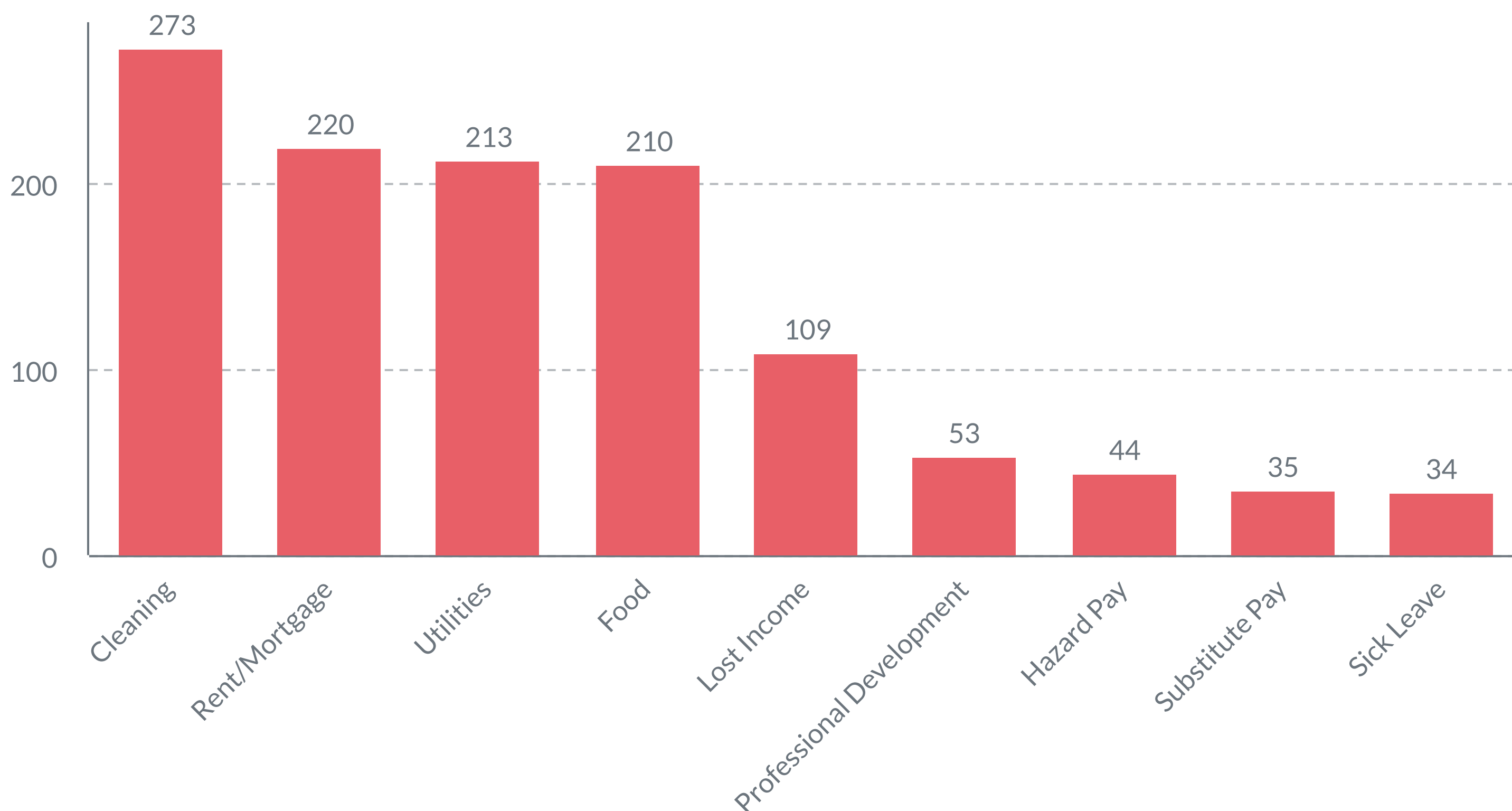

Providers Serving Families Receiving Wisconsin Shares

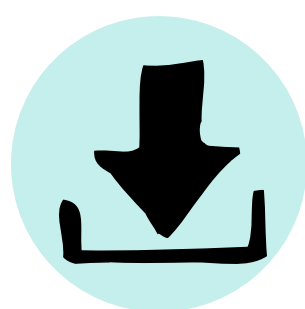


96.2% of the 443 child care programs have remained open and serving families

Having to close their program due to low enrollment and insufficient funds to pay bills



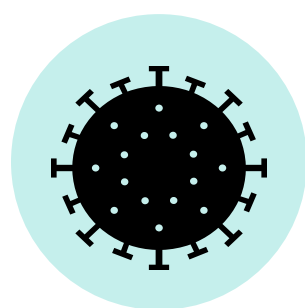
